

**INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION
PUBLIC HEARING
MARCH 27, 2012
MINUTES**

The Bolton Inland Wetlands Commission held a Public Hearing on March 27, 2012 at the Bolton Town Hall, 222 Bolton Center Road, Bolton, Connecticut.

Members present were Chairman James Loersch, Maryanne Edwards, Ross Lally and alternate Krista Edwards (acting as a regular member in Polly Silva's absence). Also present was Inland Wetlands Agent Barbara Kelly and members of the public. The Public Hearing was opened by Chairman James Loersch at 7:00 P.M.

The purpose of the public hearing was to hear public comment on Application 2012-1 – Bolton Lakes Regional Water Pollution Control Authority – to obtain a general inland wetlands permit for all the construction work associated with connecting to the sewer system within the upland review area in the town of Bolton.

Chairman Loersch read the Notice of Public Hearing. The commission and staff members introduced themselves.

Marshall Gaston and Joyce Chung were present from Fuss & O'Neill and Marshall made a presentation stating that there would be no direct wetlands impact with this work and all work is in the upland review area. He explained that there would be no need for individual homeowner applications. The homeowner would simply register with the WPCA and download the necessary individual site documents needed to complete the work. Mr. Gaston also stated that the quality of water and aquatic wildlife in Bolton Lake will be greatly improved on completion of this phase of the project.

Chairman Loersch opened the floor for public comment. Hearing none, he opened the floor to members of the commission. After a brief question and answer period, a motion was made by Ross Lally, seconded by Maryanne Edwards to close the public hearing. Motion passed unanimously. The public hearing was closed at 7:20 P.M.
