Send us an image of you and your family hiking or just enjoying the great outdoors in Bolton!

What to enter/ Where to send

Only digital photos, no hard copy photos will be accepted. Landscape (horizontal) photos are preferred (for calendar use), but vertical images can be sent too. Photos must be taken in the Town of Bolton. Images should be of appropriate subject matter, sharp and in focus, good exposure and have a balanced composition. Image resolution should be at least 300 dpi.

Submit digital photos to BoltonPhoto@aol.com (*jpeg format preferred*).

Each image submitted must include photo identification:

Photographer's name, address and phone number along with the location and date of the photo.

You must specify your photo category and give the image a title:

Example: "Moose in Bolton"- The Beauty of Nature and Wildlife

Four Categories:

*(images can be color
or black/white
any season/year)*

- 1) Beauty of Nature and Wildlife
- 2) Examples of Green Living
- 3) People in the Environment
- 4) Beauty of Open Space

Prizes will be awarded to the top three photos in each category.

Photo entries may also be featured in our 2017-2018 calendar, "Bolton A Town for All Seasons"! All prizes will be awarded at the Bolton Family Day event, held May 29th following the Memorial Day Parade, (look for the Bolton Conservation Tent).

If the event is cancelled then prizes will be awarded on Trails Day, held June 3rd.

Contest Rules

1. Eligibility: Open to all Bolton residents. (*Conservation Commission members are not eligible to enter*).
2. Photographs must be submitted by the photographer, or include written permission.
3. All entries become the property of the Town of Bolton Conservation Commission, with shared rights for unlimited reproduction in print, electronic publications and promotional materials for an unlimited period of time. Published photos will be given photo credit.
4. You may submit up to three photos per category (max. 12 photographs).
5. Entries can be submitted in either color or black and white, (*jpeg. format preferred and at least 300 dpi. or greater*).
6. Each image submitted must include the photographers name, address and phone number, location and date of the picture, along with the specific category and a photo title.
7. Be prepared to provide the Bolton Conservation Commission with written consent of anyone who appears in a photograph.
8. Photos must depict the Town of Bolton.
9. The Conservation Commission and selected judges look for images sharp in focus and exposure, balanced in composition, and show originality and creativity. All decisions by the judges are final.
10. The Bolton Conservation Commission reserves the right to adjust any prizes and/or deadline(s) as the result of causes beyond its immediate control.
