DOT officials went through the current proposed plan for the closure in the gap in the East Coast Greenway with the group. The bridge would be 19' high for trucks. The DOT officials then went through all of the alternates that they had considered and what issues precluded each from moving forward as the preferred plan. Mr. Fiano's engineer Mr. Bushnell went through some new alternatives. DOT officials will review and another meeting will be held as soon as possible to discuss results.
