

The Board of Selectmen held an informational meeting regarding Bolton Lake on November 26, 2012 at the Town Hall. Present were: First Selectman Robert Morra; Selectmen Robert Lessard and Leslie Shea (8:00); Eastern Highlands Health District Director Robert Miller; Charles Lee, DEEP; Consultant George Knoecklein; Representative Pam Sawyer; Administrative Officer Joyce Stille; and approximately 30 members of the public.

The meeting began at 7:10 P.M. with Mr. Morra providing the status report shared at the Board of Selectmen November meeting. Mr. Knoecklein gave a power point presentation which was also posted on the Town's website. The presentation included: his hypothesis as to why lake problems developed; contributing current factors; testing and drawdown information; control options; and proposed plan of approach. This was followed by a general question and answer period. The level of funding that will be required to continue lake work is still being determined. Currently there is a lake finding shortfall this year and additional funds will be necessary next year.

The meeting ended at 9:03 P.M.
