1. CALL TO ORDER

2. PRESENTATION BY RESIDENT ON WATER SUPPLY RESEARCH

Mr. Aldrich provided an in depth presentation on our water supply regulation as it relates to NFPA standards, the insurance industry and other applicable codes/regulations/standards. He has made similar presentations to the Planning and Zoning Commission and fire personnel. He is also going to meet with the Economic Development Commission. Mr. Aldrich advocates for the current regulation to be reviewed for possible changes.

3. REVIEW ON BOLTON NOTCH DAM

The group discussed the ongoing issues with Bolton Notch Dam. The Selectmen authorized Ms. Stille to send a letter to DEEP requesting the trapping of beavers; clarification of the dam work necessary and its basis; and permission to work with DEEP staff to address the dam.
