

The Board of Selectmen Facilities and Public Safety Subcommittee held a meeting on February 10, 2014 at the Town Hall. Present were: First Selectman Robert Morra; Selectmen Robert Neil and Sandra Pierog; Booster Club members Peter Phelon, John Wieczorek and Tim Callahan; Board of Education staff David Humiston and Ray Boyd; Superintendent Kristin Heckt; Buildings and Grounds Supervisor John Butrymovich; Town Engineer Joseph Dillon; and Administrative Officer Joyce Stille.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting began at 7:08 P.M.

2. DISCUSSION ON RECREATIONAL FACILITIES AND FIELDS

Mr. Dillon reviewed the revised plan and costs for Bolton High School. Work includes renovating baseball field and softball field, soccer field with a track, adding a soccer field and renovation plus adding two tennis courts. Costs for natural turf and artificial turf for the main soccer field were provided. Adding lights to the track/soccer field was discussed. In addition, the possibility of sodding the new fields was suggested. There will not be football program and a six (6) lane track is all that is necessary. As a result, could the main soccer field be slightly larger. Fencing around the track is needed.

Mr. Dillon reviewed the plan and costs for adding two ballfields at Herrick Park. The outfields would create an additional soccer field. The additional parking area will be gravel.

Mr. Dillon will contact firms to discuss the natural turf versus artificial turf costs for the next meeting.
