

The Board of Selectmen held an informational meeting on Lower Bolton Lake at the Town Hall on August 29, 2013. Present were: First Selectman Robert Morra; Selectmen Robert Neil, Robert Lessard and Ray Walker; Consultant George Knoecklein; Justin Davis, DEEP; Lake Commissioner Kim Welsh and about 35 residents.

The meeting began at 7:00 P.M. Highlights of the items discussed were as follows:

- ★ Treatments appear to be very effective
- ★ Naid weed almost completely gone
- ★ No current issues with Blue Green Algae
- ★ Isolated Fanwort growing in cove – to be treated week of 9/1/13
- ★ Clarity still not very good, appears to have some iron particles floating, turbidity present in both lakes, presents no hazards
- ★ Other levels have remained relatively constant or slightly improved
- ★ Mr. Knoecklein studying Middle Bolton Lake for Vernon now also
- ★ Expect study data collection to be completed late November and then report to follow
- ★ Catfish stocking discussed, DEEP may consider not stocking next year again based on study and Town
- ★ No word yet or drawdown of STEAP grant documents

The meeting ended at 8:10 P.M.
