

The Board of Selectmen held a retreat on April 30, 2015 at the Town Hall. Present were: First Selectman Robert Morra; Selectmen Robert Lessard, Robert Neil, Gwen Marrison and Sandra Pierog; and Administrative Officer Joyce Stille.

DISCUSSION ON TOWN OF BOLTON ISSUES

The retreat began at 7:02 P.M.

The group discussed in depth the proposed projects and timing of projects approvals. Mr. Lessard had prepared scenarios showing accumulated costs as projects were added based on different necessities or project priority. The group agreed to consider a fall Town Meeting for action on the following two (2) items: 1. replacement of fire truck; and 2. capital improvements – Bolton Center School parking lot and sidewalks, and community septic in the Town center including fire suppression cistern/pond. The second phase will be bonding for the remainder of the projects. This will include an additional \$250,000 for the Bolton High School fields project for restrooms, concession stand and lights. All of this information will be shared at the 2+2+2 meeting. Over the summer months, the group will visit other Town Halls in CT. The retreat ended at 8:55 P.M.
