The Bolton Inland Wetlands Commission held a public hearing followed by a special meeting on April 14, 2015 at the Bolton Town Hall. Members in attendance were Chairman James Loersch, Ross Lally and Jane Darico. The Inland Wetlands Agent Barbara Kelly was also in attendance. James Loersch called the meeting to order at 7:02 P.M.
