



It's time for Dog license renewals!

Dog Licenses must be purchased when a dog reaches the age of 6 months. In addition, any person who becomes the owner or keeper of any unlicensed dog of the age of six (6) months or older must license their dog within thirty (30) days thereof until the thirtieth day of the ensuing June per Connecticut General Statute Sec. 22-339.

When purchasing a dog license, a rabies certificate and a spayed/neutered certificate (if applicable) must be shown in order for a license to be issued. Licenses must be renewed annually within the month of June thereafter.

People moving to Bolton from another Connecticut town with a current dog license can transfer the license for a fee of \$ 1.00. Replacement tags for lost tags can be purchased for \$.50.

Licensing Fees:

Spayed/Neutered - \$8.00

Un-spayed/Un-neutered - \$19.00

***Kennel tags - \$51 (10 tags)**

A late fee of \$ 1.00 per month will be imposed for each dog not licensed within the month of June.

Renew by mail: please send your check [payable to the Town of Bolton], the certificate of rabies and the spay/neuter certificate, along with a self-addressed, stamped envelope for the return of your tags.

New Dogs: Supply new data either in person or by mail: (name, breed, sex, color, age.) Must bring/mail in rabies certificate and spay/neuter certificate.

*A kennel is defined as: any owner or keeper of a kennel who breeds more than two litters of dogs annually for the purposes of sale, sport or show. CGS 22-342
