

The Board of Selectmen Facilities and Public Safety Subcommittee held a meeting on February 13, 2012 at the Town Hall. Present were: First Selectman Robert Morra; Selectmen Robert Neil and Ray Walker; Fire Chief James Preuss; Deputy Fire Chief N. James Preuss; Fire Officer Dale Bonn; resident Graham McDonald; and Administrative Officer Joyce Stille.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting began at 7:00 P.M.

2. DISCUSSION ON WATER SUPPLY

Mr. Morra began the discussion by reflecting the Selectmen's goal of looking at modifications to the water supply regulations with Fire Department personnel. The current regulation is one size fits all which does not take into account use, construction, or other factors. Providing water flow and/or storage system is still the concern. The group discussed the history and reasoning behind the current regulation. The group also talked about developing design standards for a cistern. The Fire Department personnel will discuss these matters and meet again with the subcommittee.

Mr. McDonald asked about the possibility of putting a dry hydrant in the Rosedale area. Ms. Stille will set a meeting with the Chief, Town Staff and Mr. McDonald (if available) at Indian Notch Park to evaluate the feasibility.

3. OTHER TOWN BUILDINGS

The group discussed holding an informational meeting on Bolton Lake issues. The consultant will be contacted for further information as to what and when additional sampling studies would be beneficial.

4. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting ended at 8:48 P.M.
