

The Board of Selectmen (BOS) held a Public Hearing on November 6, 2014 at the Town Hall with Chair Robert Morra presiding. Also in attendance were selectmen Robert Lessard, Robert Neil and Gwen Marrion; resident Sylvia Ounpou, and Administrative Officer Joyce Stille.

Mr. Morra called the hearing to order at 7:04 P.M. The hearing was held to hear public comment on the enactment of the Energy Committee Ordinance. Mr. Morra read the Notice of Public Hearing for the record. Mr. Morra opened the floor for comments.

Sylvia Ounpou, 48 Stonehedge Lane expressed her enthusiasm for this opportunity for the town. She expressed interest in serving on the committee and asked what the time frame is to establish the committee.

Mr. Morra explained that there is a 30 day waiting period after the legal notice is in the paper. The Board will seek individuals to serve on the new committee. For outreach, Ms. Stille explained that she has a letter prepared that is signed by the First Selectman to be sent out by Northeast Utilities that includes information on the Clean Energy pledge and new committee. The letter will be sent to all residents. In addition, the information will be posted on the website and in the Bolton Bulletin. Depending on the response, Mr. Morra expects interview process will begin in January. The Finance and Administration Subcommittee will conduct the interviews.

Mr. Morra closed the hearing at 7:10 p.m.
