

**INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION
REGULAR MEETING
MAY 28, 2013
MINUTES**

The Bolton Inland Wetlands Commission held its regular meeting on May 28, 2013 at the Bolton Town Hall. Members present were Chairman James Loersch, Polly Silva, Maryanne Edwards, Jane Darico, Ross Lally and alternate Krista Edwards. Also present was Inland Wetlands Agent Barbara Kelly. The meeting was called to order by Jim Loersch at 7:00 P.M.

These wetlands permits are on-line, approved and in the system.

A motion was made by Polly Silva, seconded by Maryanne Edwards to approve the above minutes as presented. Motion passed unanimously.


7. OTHER
