

The Finance and Administration Subcommittee held a meeting on Aug. 13, 2009 at the Town Hall, Present were: First Selectman Robert Morra; Selectmen Robert Lessard and Raymond Walker; representatives from All American Waste, Frank Antonacci and George Roberts; and Administrative Officer Joyce Stille.

1. **CALL TO ORDER**
The meeting began at 3:08 P.M.

2. **DISCUSSION ON REFUSE AND RECYCLING**
The group discussed a possible extension of the current contract with modification as to the curbside pickup. Both refuse and recycling would become an automated collection service. The company would provide two 96 gallon containers to each household, one for refuse and the other for recycling. Recycling would be single stream and picked up every other week. In other communities, the single stream has resulted in a 50% increase in recycling reducing the tonnage being paid for refuse disposal. One truck would be in Town Monday through Friday picking up both refuse and recycling (split truck). Due to changes in the collection trucks, a fee will be instituted for pick ups at Town buildings. Although the change in trucks occurred several years ago, the Town had not been paying extra under the contract language. A seven year extension is being considered. Fees discussed will be forwarded to the Town for the September Board of Selectmen's meeting.
