


## Presidential Election

**November 8, 2016**

The Presidential Election will be held on November 8, 2016. Those needing to vote by absentee ballot will be able to do so starting on October 7, 2016. There are 6 qualifications that allow you to vote by absentee ballot. They are:

1. Active service in the Armed Forces of the United States
2. Absence from the town during all of the hours of voting
3. Illness
4. Religious tenets forbid secular activity on the day of the election, primary or referendum
5. Duties as a primary, election or referendum official at a polling place other than your own during all the hours of voting
6. Physical disability
